Day 01: 21ST JULY: DEPART FROM KOLKATA ARRIVE AT NAIROBI

Day 02: 22ND JULY: NAIROBI – AMBOSELI

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed for an **orientation tour of Nairobi**.

Later, journey towards **Amboseli National Park**, which is almost 210 kms, 4 hours 30 minutes' drive from Nairobi. It is "Home of the African Elephant" and is crowned by Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak. The Amboseli National Park is one of Kenya's most popular parks. It is one of the best places in Africa to view large herds of elephants up close.

On arrival at Amboseli, check-in to the resort. Freshen up and have a sumptuous lunch. In the late afternoon, proceed for game drive and enjoy the safari until dusk. Amboseli is famous for the large herds of elephants, in addition, it offers the best view of the Africans top highest mountain Mt Kilimanjaro. Later, return to the resort. Later, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay in Amboseli.



Day 3

By Road

Day 03: 23RD JULY: AMBOSELI – LAKE NAIVASHA AREA

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today, have breakfast early in the morning. Check-out from the resort and leave for **Lake Naivasha** which is a drive of approximately 6 hours (310 km).

Lake Naivasha stands as Kenya's only freshwater lake within the Great Rift Valley, positioned at 1,884 meters above sea level and just 90 kilometers north-west of Nairobi. This geographical uniqueness makes it a fascinating anomaly – while most Rift Valley lakes are alkaline due to volcanic activity and mineral deposits; Naivasha maintains its freshwater status through underground outflow and natural sedimentation processes.



On arrival, enjoy boat ride along the shores of the lake to see hippos and abundant birdlife. Then, visit **Lake Elementaita** which is a stunning, shallow, saline lake in Kenya's Great Rift Valley, famous for its vibrant birdlife, especially flamingos and Great White Pelicans, forming part of a UNESCO World Heritage site and Ramsar Wetland. It's a prime birdwatching spot, supported by rich biodiversity with mammals like Rothschild's giraffe in surrounding conservancies.



Later, check-in to the hotel near Lake Naivasha area, have dinner and stay overnight.



Day 04: 24TH JULY: LAKE NAIVASHA AREA – NAKURU – GREAT RIFT VALLEY – LAKE NAIVASHA AREA **By Road**

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a full day game drive at **Lake Nakuru National Park** which is "a beautiful wildlife haven" on the floor of the **Great Rift Valley**, surrounded by wooded and bushy grassland.



Kenya's section of the Great Rift Valley is particularly known for its diverse ecosystems and abundant wildlife. The region is home to Lake Nakuru which is famed for its flamingo population and offers a unique blend of savannah grasslands and volcanic formations.

Lake Nakuru National Park is ideal for bird watching, hiking, picnic and game drives. The lake is world-famous as the location of one of the greatest bird spectacles on earth – myriads of fuchsia pink flamingos, of which there are often more than a million or even two million. They feed on the abundant algae, which thrives in the warm waters.



In the evening, return to Lake Naivasha for an overnight stay and have dinner in the hotel.

Day 05: 25TH JULY: LAKE NAIVASHA – EQUATOR LINE – MAASAI MARA AREA

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast, proceed for the world-famous Maasai Mara – the home to the Big 5! Large numbers of lions, cheetah, elephant, rhino, African buffalo, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and many more animals are found in the park in their natural habitat, unconfined and free to roam the vast Kenyan wilderness stretching for miles on end.



En-route visit the **The Mogotio Equator Crossing**, located about 40 km from Nakuru that divides Kenya into almost two equal halves. The **Equator line** in Kenya (0° latitude) passes through the central part of the country, dividing Kenya into nearly equal northern and southern hemispheres. It is a major tourist attraction where visitors can stand in both hemispheres simultaneously and witness the Coriolis effect demonstration at markers along the A2 road.



Arrive at Maasai Mara after a drive of almost 6 hours. It is also sometimes spelled Masai Mara and locally known simply as The Mara – it is a large national game reserve in Narok, Kenya, contiguous with the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. It is named in honour of the Maasai people, the ancestral inhabitants of the area, who migrated to the area from the Nile Basin. Check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay and have dinner in the hotel. In the late afternoon, if you wish, you can visit the Maasai Mara Village to learn about their culture and dance with the natives at your own expense(optional).



Day 6

By Road

Day 06: 26TH JULY: MAASAI MARA AREA

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast, proceed for a full day game drive to view high concentration of lions, cheetahs, elephants, giraffes, zebras, and diverse antelope.

Maasai Mara is one of the most famous and important wildlife conservation and wilderness areas in Africa, world-renowned for its exceptional population of lion, African leopard, cheetah and African bush elephant. It also hosts the Great Migration, which secured it as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa and as one of the ten Wonders of the World. Enjoy packed lunch after the morning game drive.

In the afternoon, proceed for game drive that goes on till late evening in Maasai Mara. Maasai Mara game drive is a thrilling safari vehicle excursion through Kenya's iconic reserve, offering chances to see the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, rhino) and vast herds of wildebeest and zebra during the Great Migration, guided by experts through stunning grasslands, with drives typically in early mornings and late afternoons when wildlife is most active.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in the resort at Maasai Mara.

In the evening, check-in to the camp inside Maasai Mara. Later, enjoy a sumptuous dinner and stay overnight in Maasai Mara.



Day 7

By Road

Day 07: 27TH JULY: MAASAI MARA AREA – ISEBANIA – SIRARI – NORTHERN SERENGETI

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Maasai Mara and proceed to **Isebania in Kenya for crossing the border to Sirari in Tanzania**. It is the direct route between the Maasai Mara in Kenya and the Serengeti in Tanzania. From Sirari, drive to the **northern part of Serengeti** where you will enjoy **game drive near the Mara River** in the hopes of seeing some of the migratory crossing of wildebeests (completely depends on luck and watching migration cannot be promised as it is a natural phenomenon).

The endless plains of Serengeti are also the setting for the world's greatest wildlife spectacle – the 1.5 million wildebeests' endless migration in search for fresh pastures.



Each year they trek over 2,500 km and are constantly threatened and followed by some of Africa's greatest predators. The Serengeti hosts one of the world's largest land animal migration (in terms of total body weight), which helps secure it as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa. The Serengeti is also renowned for its large lion population and is one of the best places to observe prides in their natural environment. Depending on the time of your visit, your driver cum local guide will be able to share with you where the herd's current location is at Serengeti. Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Northern Serengeti Region.


Day 8

By Road

Day 08: 28TH JULY: CENTRAL SERENGETI REGION
Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, drive from **North Serengeti to Central Serengeti National Park**.

The Central Serengeti region offers superb safari all year round due to its abundance of resident animals. Specifically, the Seronera River Valley in the Central Serengeti is a 'must see' on every safari regardless of the specific month of travel. Game viewing in Central Serengeti is at its best during the dry season (June - November) as resident animals are more concentrated in the immediate area due to the lack of water on the plains. Resident herbivores include impala, buffalo, hippo, warthog, topi, hartebeest and giraffe.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Central Serengeti region.


Day 9

By Road

Day 09: 29TH JULY: CENTRAL SERENGETI REGION
Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the lodge and proceed for a full day game drive in the **Central Serengeti National Park region**.

Experience the ultimate adventure with a full day game drive in Serengeti Central, starting with a sunrise expedition across the vast plains. Witness the breathtaking sunrise igniting the savannah as majestic predators like leopards and lions begin their morning hunt. Central Serengeti (Seronera) offers premier, year-round, big-cat viewing (lions, leopards, cheetahs) in a habitat of, rocky, savannah plains and riverine woodlands. As the heart of the Serengeti, it provides excellent, consistent wildlife viewing, including the Big Five and resident, non-migratory herds, with specialized game drive loops around Seronera Valley and Kopjes.

After the game drive at dusk, return to the hotel. Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Central Serengeti region.


Day 10

By Road

Day 10: 30TH JULY: SERENGETI – NGORONGORO CRATER
Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Serengeti and proceed for a half day **game drive in Serengeti**. Later, drive to the rim of **Ngorongoro Crater**. There are several documented resident lion prides just within a one-hour game drive radius from Seronera. During the dry season, the resident prides begin to shift west and north in their territories and concentrate in the central region of the park.

The dry season is a particularly good time for lion viewing in Central Serengeti. The Central Serengeti is also one of the best areas in Africa to spot the elusive leopard. You may be lucky enough to encounter this majestic cat in the branches of the sausage trees that dot the banks of the Seronera River.

Later, check-in to the resort in Ngorongoro area, have dinner and stay overnight.



Day 11: 31ST JULY: NGORONGORO – KARATU – ARUSHA AREA

Day 11

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Ngorongoro and then start driving inside the **Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Descend into the crater for a crater game tour.**

Often called the eighth natural wonder of the world, the Ngorongoro Crater is the largest intact crater in the world. About 2 million years ago, the Ngorongoro volcano erupted and its walls collapsed. The volcano floor sank to create a natural enclosure with its 600m tall walls. Now, at over 19 kilometres wide, Ngorongoro Crater is filled with great areas of acacia forest, hippo filled swamps and open grasslands.

These different habitats contain over 30,000 animals – including elephants, warthogs, flamingoes, magnificent birdlife, the rare black rhinoceros and all the predatory cats. The Maasai can also be seen grazing their cattle alongside the buffalo and wildebeest.

On the way, pass by the town of **Karatu**, a colourful, dusty yet delightful town in the Arusha District, perfectly located on the borders of Lake Manyara National Park and Ngorongoro Crater, giving it the nickname 'Safari Junction'.

Later, drive to Arusha and check-in to the hotel. Have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.



Day 12: 01ST AUGUST: ARUSHA – KILIMANJARO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT DEPART FROM KILIMANJARO (TANZANIA)
