Day 01: 18th May, KOLKATA – SINGAPORE / KUALA LUMPUR

Day 03: 20th May, MELBOURNE CITY TOUR – PHILLIP ISLAND – MELBOURNE

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a half day **city tour of Melbourne** including the Parliament, Shrine of Remembrance, Cook's Cottage, Albert Park, Shrine of Remembrance, Parliament house, Yarra River etc.

Next, visit the iconic **Melbourne Cricket Ground**, better known as the MCG, which is one of the biggest sports stadiums in the world. With a capacity of 100,000 people, the MCG is the largest stadium in Australia. In winter the ground hosts Australian football (also known as Aussie rules or AFL) matches, while in summer it's the stage for cricket. Experience the tradition and heritage of the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground on a behind-the-scenes tour. Explore the inner sanctum of the MCG, walk along the hallowed arena and see where legends play during the guided experience.

In the afternoon, drive to **Phillip Island**, home to world's famous smallest penguins. Enjoy the Penguin Parade. The island has a grand coastline with facilities of surfing. The island has many wildlife, including the largest colony of fur seals in Australia.

Watch little penguins dash home across the sand at dusk at Phillip Island's world-famous **Penguin Parade**. Explore boardwalks after dark to see, smell and hear these

penguins in the colony, greeting neighbours, partners and their chicks. While you wander, keep an eye out for resident wildlife including swamp wallabies, seagulls, Eastern barred bandicoots, Cape Barren geese and short-tailed shearwaters.

The spectacular Great Ocean Road hugs the seaside cliffs that snake along the wild and windswept Southern Ocean. Here, there are countless ways to soak in the scenery and make the most of your coastal exploration. Take coastal photos and smell the fresh seaside air. It's a photographer's dream, with its breathtaking scenery, unique landmarks and stunning sunrises and sunsets. In the evening, drive back to Melbourne.

Have dinner in the restaurant and stay overnight in Melbourne.

See the Three Sisters rock formation, towering over Jamieson Valley. Scenic World is renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains adventure - from native birdlife and fresh air, to breathtaking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, Katoomba Falls and Jamison Valley. Experience the thrill of the world's steepest railway by **Scenic Railway**, glide between cliff tops on the glass-floored **Scenic Skyway** suspended 270 meters in the air, descend into the ancient Jamison Valley by **Scenic Cableway** and explore Jurassic rainforest along the 2.4 kilometers **Scenic walkway** - the longest boardwalk in the Southern Hemisphere.

An ancient world 30 million years in the making is brought to life by the tour guide through story-telling of its history, features and legends. Get mesmerized on seeing the stunning, delicate cave formations and enjoy a **boat ride** of 45 minutes through the starry wonderland of Arachnocampa Luminosa, thousands of magical glowworms, unique to New Zealand. Photography is not permitted in this cave.

After the tour, proceed to Rotorua. Rotorua is like nowhere else on the earth. The city is surrounded by mountains, rivers, forests and freshwater lakes, with natural hot springs perfect for bathing and relaxing.

Rotorua is the heartland of Maori culture and an ideal place to experience the traditional customs of New Zealand's indigenous people. Have dinner, check-in to the hotel and stay overnight in Rotorua.

After the tour, proceed to Auckland. Check-in to the hotel after dinner and stay overnight at Auckland.

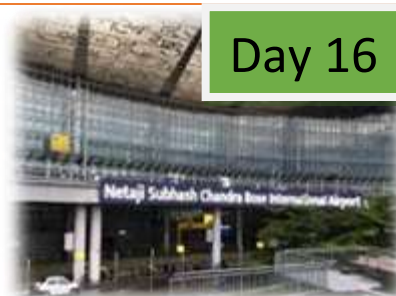
