Day 01: 18th May, KOLKATA – MELBOURNE

By Flight & Road

Meals on Board

Day 02: 19th May, MELBOURNE CITY TOUR – PHILLIP ISLAND – MELBOURNE

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a half day **city tour of Melbourne** including the Fitzroy Gardens, Cook's Cottage, Shrine of Remembrance, Parliament house, Yarra River etc.

Next, visit the iconic **Melbourne Cricket Ground**, better known as the MCG, which is one of the biggest sports stadiums in the world. With a capacity of 100,000 people, the MCG is the largest stadium in Australia. In winter, the ground hosts Australian football (also known as Aussie rules or AFL) matches, while in summer it's the stage for cricket. Experience the tradition and heritage of the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground on a behind-the-scenes tour. Explore the inner sanctum of the MCG, walk along the hallowed arena and see where legends play during the guided experience.

In the afternoon, drive to **Phillip Island**, home to world's famous smallest penguins. Enjoy the Penguin Parade. The island has a grand coastline with facilities of surfing. The island has many wildlife, including the largest colony of fur seals in Australia. Watch little penguins dash home across the sand at dusk at Phillip Island's world-famous **Penguin Parade**.

Explore boardwalks after dark to see, smell and hear these penguins in the colony, greeting neighbours, partners and their chicks. While you wander, keep an eye out for



resident wildlife including swamp wallabies, seagulls, Eastern barred bandicoots, Cape Barren geese and short-tailed shearwaters.

Return to the hotel. Have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel at Melbourne.



DAY 03: 20th May, MELBOURNE – GREAT OCEAN ROAD TOUR – MELBOURNE

After breakfast, proceed for a full day **Great Ocean Road Tour**, renowned for its stunning natural beauty and a major war memorial. Embark on a scenic drive from Melbourne along the Great Ocean Road and arrive at the wondrous **12 Apostles**. See the spectacular 45m (150ft) tall, limestone pillars. The spectacular Great Ocean Road hugs the seaside cliffs that snake along the wild and windswept Southern Ocean. Here, there are countless ways to soak in the scenery and make the most of your coastal exploration. Take coastal photos and smell the fresh seaside air. It's a photographer's dream, with its breathtaking scenery, unique landmarks and stunning sunrises and sunsets. In the evening, drive back to Melbourne.

Have dinner in the restaurant and stay overnight in Melbourne.

DAY 04: 21st May, MELBOURNE – CAIRNS – KURANDA RAINFOREST – CAIRNS

Day 4

After breakfast, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Cairns. Packed breakfast will be served.

On arriving at Cairns, proceed to the **Kuranda Rainforest**. Board the one-way **Scenic Skyrail Rainforest Cableway (Cable Car)** and one-way **Scenic Railway (Train)** to reach and depart from Kuranda village. After reaching the Kuranda village, explore the village located in the rainforest and enjoy free time by visiting local markets and shops.

Then, transfer to the hotel for check-in. Have dinner and stay overnight in Cairns.

Day 05: 22nd May, CAIRNS – GREAT BARRIER REEF – SYDNEY

By Road & Flight

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Packed Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for an excursion **Big Cat Green Island Reef Cruise Tour** with lunch. Stretching for 1,429 miles over an area of approximately 133,000 square miles, the **Great Barrier Reef** is the largest coral reef system in the world. The reef is located off the coast of Queensland, Australia, in the Coral Sea. The reef, which is large enough to be visible from space, is made up of nearly 3,000 individual reefs.

On arrival, explore the island on your own. You can opt for swimming at the Great Barrier Reef or try snorkelling at your own cost. Later, we proceed for a **glass bottom boat ride** to have a view of the colourful fishes, turtles, corals and other aquatic species.



After the tour, have lunch in the restaurant and transfer to the airport to board the flight to Sydney.

Later, check-in to the hotel and stay overnight in Sydney. Packed dinner will be served in the hotel.

Day 06: 23rd May, SYDNEY CITY TOUR & SHOWBOAT CRUISE

After breakfast, enjoy a half day **city tour of Sydney** including Darling Harbour, famous Bondi Beach, Sydney Harbour Bridge, Opera House(outside), Hyde Park, Kings Cross, CBD Area etc. Visit **Sydney Tower Eye & Sydney Sea Life Aquarium**.

After the tour, transfer to the pier to board **Showboat Cruise with dinner** (Standard seating).

Return to the hotel and stay overnight in Sydney.

DAY 07: 24th May, SYDNEY ZOO – BLUE MOUNTAINS – SYDNEY

After breakfast, proceed for a trip to **Sydney Zoo**. Meet the Aussie Big 5 at **Sydney Zoo and Wildlife Park!** From snapping a selfie with a koala, meeting a kangaroo, coming eye-to-eye with our 3 Freshwater Crocodiles, watching Ringo the Wombat play in his exhibit to watching our resident Platypus swim through the water, there's always something to explore!

Next, proceed for a tour to **Blue Mountains with Scenic World including the Scenic Railway, the Scenic Cableway, the Scenic Skyway and the Scenic Walkway**. Visit **Echo Point**. See the **Three Sisters** rock formation, towering over **Jamison Valley**. Scenic World is renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains adventure - from native birdlife and fresh air, to breathtaking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, **Katoomba Falls** and Jamison Valley. Experience the thrill of the world's steepest railway by **Scenic Railway**, glide between cliff tops on the glass-floored **Scenic Skyway** suspended 270 meters in the air, descend into the ancient Jamison Valley by **Scenic Cableway** and explore Jurassic rainforest along the 2.4 kilometers **Scenic walkway** - the longest boardwalk in the Southern Hemisphere.

Later, return to Sydney, have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel

After breakfast, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Queenstown.

Queenstown is a beautiful town on the Southern Island of New Zealand. Some marvelous and picturesque attractions make Queenstown memorable for a visit, with a backdrop of the southern alps and the stunning Lake Wakatipu. Arrive at Milford Sound Nature Cruise that offers magnificent views of the **Mitre Peak** and enjoy the **Stirling and Bowen Falls**. Enjoy a sumptuous Indian lunch buffet while sailing amidst the fjords.

The return journey along the stunning Milford Road scenic highway provides the possibility of stopping for further sightseeing or photo opportunities that may have been missed on the way into Milford. At Te Anau, you'll turn inland to Mossburn, then northwards to the little lakeside settlement of Kingston. Hug the shores of the beautiful **Lake Wakatipu** as it meanders beneath the surrounding towering mountains as you take yet another scenic journey into Queenstown.

DAY 10: 27th May, QUEENSTOWN – MT. COOK – LAKE TEKAPO/TWIZEL
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, depart for Queenstown through the stunning **Kawarau Gorge** and fruit growing region of **Cromwell**. Follow beautiful Lake Dunstan and journey through the dramatic Lindis Pass.

You'll hug the shores of magnificent blue **Lake Pukaki** as you travel up the spectacular valley to a rugged land of ice and rock, home to New Zealand's highest mountain, Aoraki **Mount Cook**.

Depart from Mount Cook region and follow the shores of Lake Pukaki to Lake Tekapo.



Enjoy a day of lovely road-side scenery. At **Lake Tekapo**, the **Church of the Good Shepherd** provides a popular photo stop sitting solitary on the shores of the lake, framed by magnificent mountains.

Transfer to the hotel for check-in after dinner followed by an overnight stay in the hotel at Lake Tekapo or Twizel.

DAY 11: 28th May, TWIZEL/LAKE TEKAPO – CHRISTCHURCH

Proceed for an orientation tour of Christchurch. The sightseeing tour covers the city highlights including drive through Canterbury University, Botanical Gardens, Riccarton House and Bush, Hagley Park etc.

Later, have dinner and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Christchurch.

DAY 12: 29th May, CHRISTCHURCH – ROTORUA

Packed breakfast will be served. Check-out from the hotel and proceed to Christchurch airport to board the domestic flight to Auckland.

On arrival, transfer to Waitomo. Enjoy 45-minute guided tour of the world-famous **Waitomo Glow Worm Caves**. An ancient world 30 million years in the making is brought to life by the tour guide through story-telling of its history, features and legends. Get mesmerized on seeing the stunning, delicate cave formations and enjoy a **boat ride** through the starry wonderland of Arachnocampa Luminosa, thousands of magical glowworms, unique to New Zealand. Photography is not permitted in this cave.



After the tour, proceed to Rotorua. Rotorua is like nowhere else on the earth. The city is surrounded by mountains, rivers, forests and freshwater lakes, with geysers and natural hot springs perfect for bathing, spa and relaxing.

Rotorua is the heartland of Maori culture and an ideal place to experience the traditional customs of New Zealand's indigenous people. Have dinner, check-in to the hotel and stay overnight in Rotorua.



DAY 13: 30th May, ROTORUA – TE PUIA – AGRODOME – AUCKLAND
Day 13

After breakfast, enjoy the Rotorua city orientation tour, including Government Gardens, Rachel Spring and Lakefront.

Just seven minutes from central Rotorua lies the geothermal valley of Wakarewarewa. Proceed for a visit to **Te Puia Maori Arts & Crafts Institute** and **Pohutu geyser**. Enjoy a 90-minute guided tour through the greenstone, wood carving and flax weaving schools at the **Maori Arts and Crafts Institute**, the **Kiwi Conservation Centre** and the **Wakarewarewa geothermal valley** and **Pohutu geyser**. After the tour, visit **Agrodome**. Witness a live sheep shearing demonstration and the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep those sheep in line.

After the tour, proceed to Auckland. Check-in to the hotel after dinner and stay overnight at Auckland.
