Day 1: 17th Oct, KOLKATA – KUNMING

Meals: Lunch & Dinner

Welcome to Smiles Per Miles Pvt. Ltd. Embark on a journey with us to one of the most popular destinations named Charming China covering Kunming, Xi'an, Beijing, Shanghai & Zhujiajiao.

Arrive at Kolkata airport three hours prior to departure and complete all the necessary formalities under the guidance of our Tour Manager before boarding the flight from Kolkata to Kunming.

On arrival at Kunming, complete all immigration formalities. Later, board the coach and proceed to visit the **Stone Forest**. The quintessential crust landscape makes every tourist lost in wonder. The Stone Forest, or Shilin, is a spectacular UNESCO World Heritage site in Yunnan province of China, featuring dramatic 270-million-year-old limestone karst formations. Located about 77-90 km from Kunming, these towering, jagged rock pillars were formed by water and wind erosion over millions of years.

Later, visit the largest shopping mall in China from where you can buy various tourist souvenirs and all kinds of native and special handmade products. Also visit the famous **Flower Market**.

Later, have dinner in the restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 2: 18th Oct, KUNMING – XI'AN

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to the airport to board the flight from Kunming to Xi'an.

On arrival at Xi'an, proceed for **guided city tour of Xian including City Wall and Big Wild Goose Pagoda**. As one of the key Buddhist structures built in the Tang Dynasty, the Little Wild Goose Pagoda has long been a place to light incense and pray. The exquisite appearance, beautiful craft and mysterious Buddhist ambiance makes the Little Wild Goose Pagoda a must-see destination

Visit **Shuyuanmen** which has become a tourist spot with a cultural atmosphere, including shopping, dining, recreation and sightseeing. Situated on the eastern side of the South Gate, Shuyuanmen, namely Shuyuan Gate, is a cultural street factually restored in the style of the ancient architectures of the Ming (1368-1644) and Qing (1644-1911) dynasties. You may taste the true life of people in Xi'an and find the remains of an ever dynasty. Later, watch the **Bell and Drum tower** (outside view), building with carved beams and painted rafters which has been served as the symbol of Xi'an. After the tour, enjoy **Tang Dynasty Show**.

Later, have dinner in a restaurant and stay overnight in Xi'an.

Day 3: 19th Oct, XI'AN – OVERNIGHT TRAIN TO BEIJING

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Packed Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for the tour to **Terracotta Warriors & Horses** and the **Ceramic Factory**. Nestled within the "Emperor Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Site Museum" in Lintong District of Xi'an City, the Terracotta Army, also known as Terracotta Warriors and Horses, lies approximately an hour's drive from the city center. Constructed by Emperor Qin Shi Huang (259 BC - 210 BC), the first emperor of a unified China, to safeguard his mausoleum, it constitutes an underground legion composed of life-sized terracotta warriors and horses. Revered as the "Eighth Wonder of the World," it stands as one of the two remaining "Wonders of the World" and has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Later visit the **Muslim Quarter**, a snack and commercial street situated in the center part of Xi'an



Later, proceed to the station to board the overnight soft sleeper train to Beijing. Packed dinner will be served.

Day 4

By Road

Day 4: 20th Oct, BEIJING

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Arrive at Beijing in the morning. De-board the train and board the coach. Proceed for a guided city tour of Beijing including the Forbidden City - an abiding symbol of traditional China. Beijing's **Forbidden City** - the world's largest wooden royal building complex, is called that because access was strictly forbidden to commoners and most officials for centuries, with unauthorized entry punishable by death, reflecting the emperor's supreme power as the "Son of Heaven". Its Chinese name, Zijincheng, also links it to the celestial "Purple Forbidden City" (the North Star's realm) where the Jade Emperor lived, making the palace the earthly counterpart to heaven, further emphasizing its sacred, exclusive nature.

Later, visit **Tiananmen Square**, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site within the Beijing Central Axis, is the largest central plaza in the world. As the site of numerous significant events throughout Chinese history, it holds immense political, historical, and cultural importance. The surrounding halls and museums, including the Great Hall of the People and the National Museum of China, offer rich insights into China's heritage.

Later, have dinner in the restaurant and stay overnight in the hotel at Beijing.



Day 5: 21st Oct, BEIJING
Day 5 By Road

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, visit **Shichahai Lake** (it's also called Houhai). Located in the bustling centre of Beijing, there's a picturesque and tranquil area full of charm known as Shichahai. It is regarded as a gem of Beijing and a cultural and historical preservation site of China. Alongside its clear blue lakes, Shichahai also boasts many distinctive scenic spots and enjoyable activities. It is a treasure-chest of lively bars and nightspots. Shichahai is a 600-year-old building complex in Beijing. It used to be the back garden of the royal palace of the Qing Dynasty. Now it is a famous "Beijing Style" cultural center, including 3 water zones and many characteristic buildings with unique Chinese traditional folk style.



Next, visit **Wangfujing Street** which is a premier 1.8 km pedestrianized shopping destination in Beijing's Dongcheng District, near the Forbidden City. It features a mix of high-end malls, traditional shops, bookstores and famous eateries like Quanjude Roast Duck. Situated in the heart of Beijing, it is often called the "Golden Street" and is the main shopping district in the central of Beijing. The area offers a blend of luxury brands, international retailers and traditional Chinese handicrafts.



In the evening, enjoy **Acrobatic Show**, a thrilling display of artistry and human prowess. Featuring mind-blowing tricks, death-defying acts, graceful choreography loaded with colour and excitement, it's probably the most versatile nightlife event in the city that will leave you with plenty of memories and stunning photos. Return to the hotel after dinner for an overnight stay.


Day 6: 22nd Oct, BEIJING

Day 6
Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a guided tour of Beijing including **Great Wall of China** tour by cable car. Cable cars offer a convenient, scenic way to access different sections of the Great Wall of China with beautiful views allowing visitors to reach watchtowers quickly for stunning perspectives. One of the world's most popular tourist attractions, the millennia-old Great Wall of China attracts millions of visitors each year. The Great Wall was continuously built from the 3rd century BC to the 17th century AD on the northern border of the country as the great military defence project of successive Chinese Empires, with a total length of more than 20,000 kilometers. The Great Wall begins in the east at Shanhaiguan in Hebei province and ends at Jiayuguan in Gansu province to the west. Its main body consists of walls, horse tracks, watch towers, and shelters on the wall and includes fortresses and passes along the Wall.



Next, view the **Bird's Nest**(outside)which is the National Stadium in Beijing that served as the main venue of 2008 Summer Olympics. The now-empty stadium continues to function as a tourist attraction, while hosting sports and entertainment events. The stadium, shaped like a nest, was meant to symbolize the cradle of life and hope in the future of mankind.



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Later, visit The National Aquatics Center, also known as the '**Water Cube**'(outside) which is one of the most dramatic and exciting sporting venues constructed for the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. It served as the iconic design showpiece of the Beijing Olympics.

Next, enjoy the **Hutong tour**. Hutongs are bunch preserved old city sections and it is treat to walk/cycle through these narrow alleys along with multiple activities i.e. Peking Opera mask painting etc. Wander through 1.5 miles (2.5km) of Beijing's historic hutong alleyways, soaking in the city's past while taking delightful breaks to savour local bites. Visit the narrow lanes lined with traditional courtyard homes. Peek into daily life of the local people, snack on street favourites and ride a rickshaw(optional) near the Drum and Bell Towers for a dose of old Beijing.

Later, have a view of the Summer Palace and Silk Market before returning to the hotel after dinner for an overnight stay.



Day 7: 23rd Oct, BEIJING – SHANGHAI

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, transfer to the train station to board the super-fast **bullet train to Shanghai**.

On arrival at Shanghai, board **The Shanghai Maglev Train** which is the world's first commercial high-speed magnetic levitation line, operating at speeds of 300–431 km/h (186–268 mph) between **Pudong International Airport** and **Longyang Road station**. It covers 30 km (19 miles) in about 8 minutes, floating on electromagnetic fields with no friction.

Later, proceed to visit the **Jade Buddha Temple** – famous for two jade Buddha statues, one of which is reclining and the other seated. It's not just a unique architectural structure, but also a treasure trove of Chinese Buddhism passed down through generations as a place of solace, peace and tranquility, ideal for prayers. The Jade Buddha Temple is important because it houses one of the largest collections of Buddhist scripture in China and is home to numerous statues made of jade, gold and marble. Later, leave for a visit to the Silk Shop and spend some time walking on the bund.

In the evening, visit **Xintiandi** in Shanghai – a premier, upscale car-free shopping and entertainment district known for its beautifully restored 20th-century Shikumen (stone gate) houses blended with modern, high-end boutiques, bars, Shikumen buildings, galleries, fashion shops, themed restaurants, coffee shops and dining. Located near Madang Road, it is a popular tourist, dining, and nightlife spot, often visited for its unique mix of historic atmosphere and contemporary luxury.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to Zhujiajiao from Shanghai which is approximately a drive of 45 minutes.

On arrival at **Zhujiajiao**, enjoy a half day city tour including **Chenghuang Temple**, gardens and market. Shanghai's City God Temple, in English or Shanghai Chenghuang Miao, is the commonest, most attractive place and shopping corner for visitors. It is a well-known Taoist temple in that area and is one of the must-see attractions when visiting Shanghai. Later, return to Shanghai.

Enjoy **Huangpu River cruise** in Shanghai showcasing iconic skyline views of the Bund and Pudong's skyscrapers, particularly stunning during evening from neon-lit night cruises. Cruises generally travel between the Waibaidu Bridge and the Yangpu or Nanpu Bridge, providing views of the Bund and the Oriental Pearl Tower.

Later, have dinner in the restaurant and return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

After a relaxed breakfast, check-out from the hotel and transfer to the airport to board the flight to Kolkata via Kunming after completing all immigration formalities.
