Day 03: 19TH AUG, MADRID

Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a **guided tour of Madrid** including views of **Puerta del Sol** featuring the **Kilometer Zero plaque** and the **Bear and Strawberry Tree statue**, Madrid's official symbol, **Plaza Mayor**, **Puerta de Alcalá**, **Gran Vía**, **Plaza de Cibeles**. Visit **Royal Palace**, the official residence of the Spanish family. Then, enjoy a photo stop at **Las Ventas Bullring Arena** in Madrid (**Entry ticket Optional - Additional Cost**). Next, proceed for admission to **Santiago Bernabéu Stadium Tour** in Madrid.

Later, proceed to the famous **Flamenco Show with a sumptuous local dinner**. Flamenco, which UNESCO recently recognized as a part of the World's Intangible Cultural Heritage, is a complex art form incorporating poetry, singing (cante), guitar playing (toque), dance (baile), polyrhythmic hand-clapping (palmas), and finger snapping (pitos).

Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 04: 20TH AUG, MADRID – TOLEDO – AVILA – SALAMANCA

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to Toledo, an ancient city set on a hill above the plains of Castilla-La Mancha in central Spain. Toledo is a historic city in central Spain, known as the "City of Three Cultures" for its blend of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish history. It is a UNESCO World Heritage site that features medieval streets, the Alcázar fortress, and the Toledo Cathedral. It is famous for its traditional metalwork. Enjoy an **orientation tour of Toledo** including an outside view of the **Alcazar Fortress and Tagus River from Mirador Del Valle, Toledo Cathedral, the Monastery of San Juan de Los Reyes, City gates and bridge, Plaza Zocodover and the Sword Factory or Museum of the Swords.**

Later, proceed for a guided tour of **Avila**, one of the oldest cities in Spain. Surrounded by well-preserved medieval walls from the XI century, resembles rather an immense castle and is the best sample of a fortified city.

Visit the **walls of Avila (Las Murallas de Ávila), Monasterio de St. Thomas, Mayor Square, Basilica de San Vicente, Cathedral de Avila, The Four Posts, Convento de Santa Teresa, Palacio Caprotti, Casco Historico de Avila and all other major attractions.** etc.

Next, proceed to Salamanca. Check-in to the hotel, have dinner and stay overnight.

DAY 05: 21ST AUG, SALAMANCA – COIMBRA – LISBON

Meals: Breakfast & Packed Dinner

After **breakfast**, proceed for a guided tour of Salamanca. Salamanca is known as the "Golden City," and is a UNESCO World Heritage site celebrated for its stunning, honey-coloured sandstone architecture and the historic **University of Salamanca** (founded in 1218), one of Europe's oldest. Located in Castile and León, it is renowned for its lively student atmosphere, the magnificent Plaza Mayor, and two conjoined, 12th-18th century cathedrals. The Old (Romanesque) and New (Gothic) cathedrals are joined together, featuring a 1992 restoration detail of an astronaut on the facade. Visit **Salamanca Cathedral** along with view of the view of Convento de San Esteban, Salamanca University, Church of Saint Martin, Plaza Mayor and Salamanca Central Market.

Next, proceed towards **Coimbra**. Visit the **Coimbra University**, one of the oldest in the world with its magnificent **Baroque Library (Biblioteca Joanina)** and its unique atmosphere characterized by ancient traditions and customs, such as black cape of the student and the melancholic fad of music. Visit **St. Clara Church**, where lies the tomb of Queen St. Isabel, the protagonist of the "miracle of roses". In the centre, you can admire the exclusive ceramic of Coimbra.

Later, proceed to Lisbon. Check-in to the hotel followed by dinner and stay overnight.

DAY 06: 22ND AUG, LISBON – SINTRA – LISBON
Day 6
By Road
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a guided tour of Lisbon. Then, visit **Jeronimos Monastery**, one of the most prominent examples of the late Portuguese Gothic Manueline style of architecture in Lisbon where Vasco da Gama Luís de Camões, King Manuel I, King John III and many members of the royal family are buried. Then, visit **Padrao dos descobrimentos (Discovery Monument)**. Located along the Tagus river where ships departed to explore and trade with India and the Orient, the monument celebrates the Portuguese Age of Discovery (or "Age of Exploration") during the 15th and 16th centuries. Later, view the **Belem Tower**, built in the 16th century, to defend Lisbon from enemy ships and incoming raids along the Tagus River. It also marked the beginning of voyages for sailors. It is currently under restoration and the entrance is restricted to the public.

Next, proceed to Sintra to visit **Pena Palace**. The Pena Palace is a Romanticist castle in São Pedro de Penaferrim, in the municipality of Sintra, on the Portuguese Riviera. The castle stands on the top of a hill in the Sintra Mountains above the town of Sintra. Its historic center is famous for its 19th-century Romanticist architecture, historic estates and villas, gardens and royal palaces and castles, which resulted in the classification of the town as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Next, enjoy a scenic drive along the Atlantic coast and proceed to **Cabo Da Roca** - the cliffs of **Cape Roca**, the westernmost point of mainland Portugal or European continent and Eurasian landmass, located at the very end of the Sintra Mountains. Standing at the most westerly point on mainland Europe, Cabo da Roca provides an unrivalled panoramic view out over the immensity of the Atlantic Ocean. The imposing lighthouse, with its tower finished in white tiles and with a red walkway, stands out as one of the oldest in Portugal. The Cabo da Roca is one of the most iconic places in Portugal and a magical spot to watch the sunset.

Later, return to Lisbon, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.


Day 07: 23RD AUG, LISBON – SEVILLE
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Lisbon and proceed towards Seville.

On arrival, visit the important landmarks of Seville including view of **Plaza Espana**, Santa Cruz Quarter and Maria Luisa Park. Later, visit **Seville Cathedral and Giralda Tower**. The official name of the **Cathedral of Seville** is "*Catedral de Santa María de la Sede*" and it is the largest church in the world, after St. Peter's Basilica in Rome and St. Paul's Cathedral in London. The minaret of the Cathedral, **La Giralda**, is the tower of the mosque that was preserved after the demolition of the mosque when it was replaced by a cathedral. Then, enjoy **Guadalquivir River Cruise in Seville**, the only navigable river in Spain.

Later, have dinner in the restaurant followed by check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay at Seville.

Day 08: 24TH AUG, SEVILLE – CORDOBA – MALAGA – GRANADA
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a **guided tour of Cordoba** including view of Roman Bridge, La Juderia, Palacio de Viana, Old Jewish Quarter and all other major attractions, followed by admission to **Cordoba Mezquita**.

Later, proceed to **Malaga**, a coastal town in the sunny **Costa del Sol**. Visit **Picasso Museum** in Malaga, known for being the seaside birthplace of Pablo Picasso. Malaga beaches attract a significant number of tourists each year, especially in the summer months. The golden sand and sparkling sea are among the Spanish city's greatest assets. Visit **La Farola**, a 19th-century whitewashed lighthouse located close to the Port of Málaga and **La Malagueta Beach**, Málaga's most iconic urban beach and other attractions.

Next, proceed to Granada and on arrival, check-in to the hotel. Later, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay in Granada.

DAY 09: 25TH AUG, GRANADA – VALENCIA
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to visit Granada - Andalucía's splendid Moorish architectural heritage. Enjoy a **guided tour of Granada** including visit to **Alhambra Complex, Water Gardens of Generalife** along with view of **Albaicin, Alcazaba, Palace of Charles V, Gate of Justice (Puerta de la Justicia), Wine Gate (Puerta del Vino), hammams, Alhambra Canons, Partal Palace and Gardens and many fortified towers**. Known for its impressive Islamic architecture and notable examples of Spanish Renaissance architecture along with majestic **Generalife** gardens, the Alhambra is a living testimony to the splendour of Al-Andalus. Explore **Alcazaba**, the oldest fortress in the complex, where you can enjoy panoramic views of Granada from the Torre de la Vela (watchtower).

Later, proceed to Valencia. On arrival, have dinner in the restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay.

La Tomatina is a festival that is held in the Valencian town of **Buñol**, in the east of Spain 30 kilometers from the Mediterranean, in which participants throw tomatoes and get involved in a tomato fight purely for entertainment purposes.

Next, drive back to the hotel in Valencia to freshen up. Later, in the evening, proceed to visit **Malvarrosa Beach** followed by dinner in the restaurant. Return to the hotel and stay overnight in Valencia.

DAY 11: 27TH AUG, VALENCIA – BARCELONA

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed for a **guided tour of Valencia** including outside visit of City of Arts and Science including the Opera House and Oceanographic Museum Complex, Quart Towers, Valencia Old Gate, Torres de Serranos(Serrano Towers), University of Valencia, La Reina Square, Plaza de la Virgen(Virgin Plaza) , Turia Fountain, Valencia Cathedral, La Almoina Square, Santos Juanes Church, Lonja De La Seda(Silk Exchange)and the Mercado Central.

Next, visit **Lladro Museum** in Valencia followed by entrance to **Nou Mestella Stadium**.

Next, proceed to the railway station to board the train from Valencia to Barcelona.

DAY 12: 28TH AUG, BARCELONA

After breakfast, proceed for a **guided city tour of Barcelona** including outside view of National Museum of Arts, Plaza de España, La Rambla, Olympic Stadium, Olympic Village, Columbus Monument, Casa Mila La Pedrera, Casa Batlló, and Arc de Triomf.

Then, proceed to visit **Sagarada Familia** - a massive, unfinished Catholic church designed by Antoni Gaudí. Begun in 1882 and listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is special for its artistic, intricate, unique and innovative nature-inspired Art Nouveau Catalan Modernism architecture by Antoni Gaudí. Nearing completion in 2026, it will become the world's tallest church. Its incredible symbolism tells the story of Christianity and the life of Christ, creating a forest-like interior with stunning natural light which remains a testament to centuries of faith, art and engineering.

Later, proceed to visit **Park Guell**, one of the outstanding examples of Catalan Modernism and an unmissable destination for anyone visiting Barcelona. The waving balcony and the colourful Guard's House, with the imposing Barcelona skyline and sea in the background, is the city's favorite postcard. It is an architectural masterpiece, with tree-shaped columns and undulating forms that merge in perfect harmony. The colours of the broken tile mosaics that cover the surface of the distinct elements is an unprecedented technique of Gaudí that makes the astonishing shapes come to life. It was also built in the middle of the city atop a hill, hence it is blessed with some of the best views in Barcelona.

Later, proceed to the restaurant for dinner and return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Barcelona.



DAY 13: 29TH AUG, BARCELONA – DEPARTURE FROM BARCELONA AIRPORT

After breakfast, proceed to visit to **Montjuïc Castle by Montjuïc cable car**. The Montjuïc Cable Car (Telefèric de Montjuïc) offers a scenic, direct route to the 17th-century Montjuïc Castle atop Montjuïc Hill at the summit in Barcelona, offering 360-degree panoramic views, featuring Barcelona city, port, and sea views. Its 750 meters of route allows tourists to gaze at unparalleled views, culminating the journey in the Montjuïc Castle, on the top of a mountain that represents the living history of the city. Built in the 1600s as a military fortress, **Montjuïc Castle** has played many roles over the centuries. It was an important structure in coastal defense, then became a prison during tumultuous times in Spanish history. Today, it's a peaceful public space with beautiful views and cultural exhibits.

Next, proceed to view **Camp Nou Stadium** (outside view as it is under renovation) or **FC Barcelona Museum** (entrance optional, subject to availability – additional cost).

In the evening, proceed to the Barcelona airport. Complete all immigration formalities before boarding the flight from Barcelona back home.
