Day 03: 28TH MAY, PRAGUE

Meals : Breakfast, Light Lunch & Local Dinner

This morning after breakfast, take a guided city tour of Prague. Visit the remarkable **Prague Castle** which is said to be the biggest castle in the world at about 570 meters in length and an average of about 130 meters wide.

The Czech Crown Jewels are kept here. The castle will attract you with many breathtaking sights such as St. Vitus's Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, the Basilica of St. George, the Golden Lane and a lot of amazing sights spread over Prague. See the **St. Vitus Cathedral** the seat of the Archbishop of Prague. Then we will pass through Mostecká Street to see the famous medieval **Charles Bridge**, famous mostly for the series of Baroque statues that adorn the bridge's balustrade and eventually arrive at the **old town square** to witness the unique walk of the apostles to the medieval **astronomical clock**.

Then, we will continue our exploration of Prague by cruising along the Vltava River, also known as Moldova River. Get set for **Vltava River Cruise with local dinner**. As you enjoy the **Vltava River Cruise**, admire the iconic landmarks of Prague's historical centre including the Prague Castle, Charles Bridge, Kampa Island etc. and enjoy a sumptuous local dinner on cruise. Later, return to the hotel and stay overnight at Prague.

Day 04: 29TH MAY, PRAGUE – CESKY KRUMLOV – LINZ – SALZBURG

Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Prague and proceed to **Cesky Krumlov**, a town in the south Bohemian region of Czech Republic. In a guided tour, visit **Cesky Krumlov Castle**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and admire the castle courtyards and gardens, **Old Town and Cloak Bridge**.

Next, drive through Linz and stop at **Hauptplatz** – the Main Square that forms the centre of Linz and is the venue for variety of events, markets, shops, culinary delights and serves as a location for versatile events. Linz, a UNESCO City of Media Arts is home to the renowned **Ars Electronica Centre** (also known as "Museum of the Future") that promotes digital arts.

Then, proceed to **Salzburg** - the city of Sound of Music. It is one of Europe's most beautiful cities, both for its architecture and for its magnificent setting. This picturesque city stretches along both banks of the River Salzach as it emerges from the Salzburg Alps. On arrival, meet a local English-speaking guide and proceed for a **guided walking city tour including the Mirabell Gardens and Palace, Pegasus Fountain, Fortress Hohensalzburg, Salzburg Cathedral, Schloss Hellbrunn, Mozart's residence and Mozartplatz**(all outside view). End the tour with a visit to **Mozart's Birthplace (entrance included)**.

Day 05 : 30TH MAY, SALZBURG – ST. GILGEN – HALLSTATT – GRUNDLSEE
Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel at Salzburg and proceed towards Hallstatt. Enroute, stop at **St. Gilgen** which is a traveller's paradise. From breathtaking scenery to rich culture, St. Gilgen has something for everyone. Visit **Woolfgangsee Lake** and experience an unforgettable view for a lifetime sitting beside the charming lakeside promenade.

Nestled in the beautiful Austrian Alps, lies the picturesque town of **Hallstatt**. This fairytale village totally lives up to its hype. Pastel-coloured houses, cobblestone streets filled with charming cafes and inns overlook the Hallstatt lake and impressive mountains. Hallstatt enchants in Austria's Salzkammergut mountains. The Salzkammergut region boasts crystal-clear lakes, majestic alpine scenery, traditional villages with rich cultural heritage. Enjoy a **boat trip** on Lake Hallstätter See and enjoy the tranquility and sublime views. Visit the Hallstatt **panoramic viewpoint, waterfall, Hallstatt Funicular and Skywalk**(subject to operation), **Bone House in Hallstatt Ossuary** located in the Chapel of St. Michael, **Marktplatz** and stroll around in the streets and charming village.

Next, proceed to **Grundlsee**.

Grundlsee is a charming small town located in the Salzkammergut. It is an area of spectacular natural beauty in the center of incredible Austria. The Grundlsee lake with impressive mountain drop is one of the most beautiful sights you'll see.

Later, enjoy a sumptuous dinner followed by check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 06 : 31ST MAY, GRUNDLSEE - VIENNA
Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to Vienna which is almost 3 hours' drive.

Next, visit the **Palace and Gardens of Schönbrunn** which is outstanding as one of the most impressive and well preserved Baroque ensembles of its kind in Europe. Additionally, it is a potent material symbol of the power and influence of the House of Habsburg over a long period of European history, from the end of the 17th to the early 20th century. It is impossible to separate the gardens from the palace, of which they form an organic extension. This is an excellent example of the concept of Gesamtkunstwerk, a masterly fusion of many art forms.

Next, proceed for a **guided city tour of Vienna** including **St. Stephen's Cathedral, outside view of Hofburg Palace, Belvedere Palace, City Hall, Austrian Parliament, Judenplatz Holocaust Memorial, Column of Pest, Maria-Theresien-Platz, Opera House, Ringstrasse, Stadpark** (all from outside).

Have dinner and check-in to the hotel at Vienna.

Day 6

Day 07 : 1ST JUNE, VIENNA – BRATISLAVA – BUDAPEST
Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Vienna and proceed to Bratislava – the capital and the largest city of Slovakia. Enjoy a guided walking tour of the city. Start with **Hviezdoslavovo Square** and discover the Opera House and Reduta Building. Admire the Man Work statue in the city's Main Square. Pause at the Roland fountain and hear the legend of the knight Rowland. Take a photo with a Napoleonic soldier as you pass by the Old Town Hall. Stroll through Primate's square to Franciscan Square. Marvel at one of Bratislava's hidden gems: Primate's Palace. Take in the stunning Micheal's Gate. See the palace where the Hungarian Parliament used to meet. End the walking portion of your tour at the gates of St. Martin's Cathedral. Continue to drive by the Presidential Palace in Palisady District, which was built in the functionalist style. Visit **Bratislava Castle** and see the Slovak Government building, Most SNP, Devan Castle etc. Finish your tour with a visit to the Slavin Monument, where you can enjoy a superb view over all of Bratislava. Then, proceed to Budapest, the Hungarian capital and the second largest city on River Danube.

In the evening, enjoy the romantic **Duna Bella Cruise** on River Danube for an hour. Board a wonderful cruise and marvel at the evening sights and history of the nearby attractions of the guided Budapest river cruise boat, Duna Bella, the panaroma boat of the Legenda fleet.

Later, have a sumptuous dinner in the restaurant and check-in to the hotel at Budapest.

Day 08 : 2ND JUNE, BUDAPEST

In the evening, enjoy **Folklore Hungarian Dance show**. This authentic folk show will provide entertainment from one of the top ensembles in the country.

Day 09 : 3RD JUNE, BUDAPEST – KRAKOW
Meals : Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Budapest and proceed towards Krakow, a city in southern Poland, known for its well-preserved medieval core, Jewish quarter, breathtaking sights and intriguing places. It is the second largest and one of the oldest cities in Poland, situated on the Vistula River.

On arrival, proceed for a guided tour including visit to the **Old Town**, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978, one of the world's first sites granted the status.

Then, visit Krakow Cloth Hall at Main Square and pass by Town Hall Tower, Krakow's Central Square and the Mickiewicz Monument, Kazmierz Former Jewish district, Florianska Street. Also visit **Wawel Royal Castle (castle ground complex)**, **Monument of Pope John Paul II in Wawel Hill**, Wawel Cathedral, St. Peter and Paul Church, St. Florian's Church etc.

Later, have dinner and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Krakow.

Day 9

Day 10: 4TH JUNE, KRAKOW – AUSCHWITZ – WIELICZKA – KRAKOW
Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, drive to Auschwitz. On arrival at the **Auschwitz Concentration Camp**, take a guided tour of what was addressed as "The Hell On Earth".

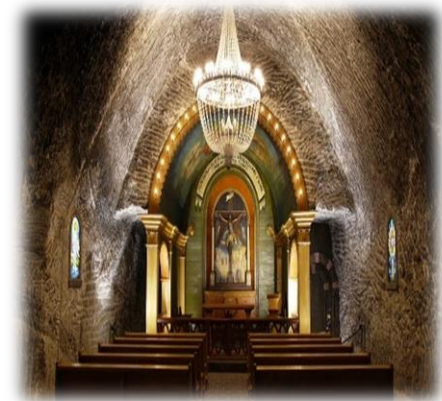
The concentration camp in Auschwitz was established by Nazis on the outskirts of the town Oswiecim in 1940. After the war, the camp was turned into museum displaying evidence of the genocide. Block no. 11, known as the Death Block, was where people were murdered and also called the "Wall of Death". Outside the camp, there is a gas chamber, where approx. 70,000 people were killed.

In 1942-1945, approx. 1.5 million people lived and died here. 90% of them were the Jews; others were Poles, Gypsies, Russians and prisoners from 28 countries. Since 1944, transports of prisoners from all over the continent entered directly through the "Gate of Death". In 1979 Auschwitz – Birkenau Concentration Camp was listed a UNESCO World Culture and National Heritage Site.

Next, visit **Wieliczka Salt Mines**, one of the world's oldest salt mines in operation from the 13th century until 2007 producing table salt. Commercial mining was discontinued in 1996, because of salt prices going down and also mine flooding. The mine is currently one of Poland's official national historic monuments, whose attractions include dozens of statues and four chapels carved out of the rock salt by the miners, along with supplemental carvings made by contemporary artists.

Have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel at Krakow.

Day 11 : 5TH JUNE, KRAKOW – WARSAW

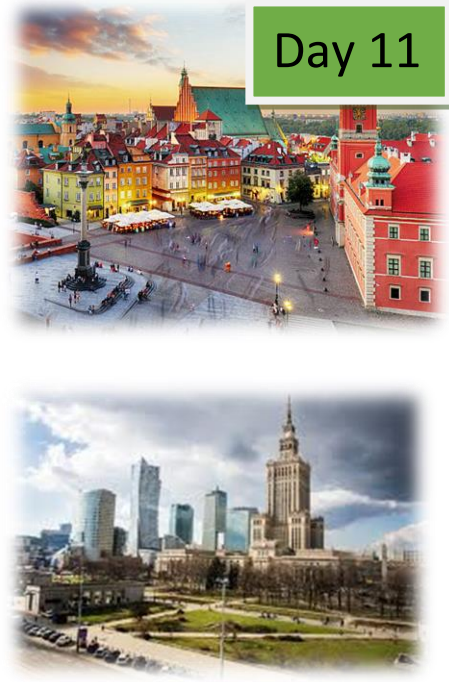
Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

This morning after breakfast, proceed to Warsaw, the capital and largest city of Poland. Enjoy a guided walking city tour of Warsaw.

Enjoy a photo stop at **Monument to the Ghetto Heroes, Chopin Monument, Copernicus Statue, Wilanow Palace, King Sigismund's III Column** located at **Castle Square, Palace of Culture, Lazienki Palace, Warsaw Uprising Monument, Warsaw's Old Town**, where the **Royal Castle** is located, **Archcathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist**, one of the most important churches in Warsaw, **Umschlagplatz**, one of the most heartbreaking places in Warsaw - on this square, Nazis loaded Jewish people into carriages and transported them to Treblinka concentration camp. Journey along the "**Royal Route**" admiring the aristocratic residences and famous monuments. Pass through the UNESCO World Heritage-designated **Old Town Market Square, Castle Square**, and the **Praga District**. Admire the "**Palace on the Water**," the lavish summer residence of the last King of Poland, Stanislaw August Poniatowski and The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Witness the **Presidential Palace and Warsaw University buildings**.

Later, have dinner and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Warsaw.
