Day 01: 2ND MAR, KOLKATA – MUMBAI

By Flight AI 2482 20:35/23:30 HRS.

Meals: Meal on Board

Welcome to Smiles Per Miles Pvt. Ltd. Embark on a journey with us to one of the most ancient destinations of the world named **Classical Jordan & Spiritual Israel**.

Arrive at Kolkata airport two hours prior to the departure and complete all the formalities under the guidance of our Tour Manager before boarding the flight to Mumbai.

Day 1



Day 02: 3RD MAR, MUMBAI – AMMAN – MADABA – KARAK – PETRA **By Flight & Road RJ 191 05:15/09:00 HRS.**

Meals: Meal on Board, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

Board the connecting flight from Mumbai to Amman after completing all immigration formalities.

Arrive at Queen Alia International Airport in Amman, Jordan in the morning and meet and get assisted by our local attendant to complete the arrival visa formalities. Then, proceed to Petra and en-route have lunch.

Explore **Madaba**, best known for its Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Visit Saint George's Church, see the 'Madaba Map', the oldest preserved mosaic map of the Holy Lands. Continue south to the ancient crusader castle in **Karak**, exploring the maze of the stone- vaulted halls and passageways. The city of Karak was the capital of Moab and the castle dominates the skyline. The castle provides an impressive insight into the architectural and military skills of the Crusaders.

Drive towards Petra. Petra is an ancient city, center of the Arab and Nabatean kingdom during Hellenistic and Roman period, the ruins of which are now in south-west Jordan. Check-in to the hotel. Later, have dinner and return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Petra.

DAY 03: 4TH MAR, PETRA – AQABA

Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to **explore Petra**. Marvel at the beauty of the 'Lost City', the Red Rose City of Petra, exploring its many caves and tombs. Petra is famous for its magnificent rock-cut architecture, including the iconic Treasury, and its status as a New Seven Wonder of the World and UNESCO World Heritage Site. The ancient city's "Rose City" appearance, due to its pink sandstone cliffs and its historical significance as a wealthy, ancient trading hub controlled by the Nabataeans also contribute to its fame. Walk through the canyon and be astounded at the magnificent **Treasury**, the entrance guarding the ancient city, followed by the Roman ruins and amphitheater.



After the tour, drive to **Aqaba**. As the gateway city to the famous desert landscapes of Wadi Rum, Aqaba receives a good share of tourists and holds a reputation for rich marine life in its warm **Red Sea** waters.

It is the only coastal city in Jordan and the largest and most populous city on the **Gulf of Aqaba**.


Day 4

By Road

DAY 04: 5TH MAR, AQABA – WADI RUM
Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, drive to **Wadi Rum**, a protected incredible desert valley wilderness in southern Jordan filled with narrow gorges, towering cliffs and natural stone arches. Home to nomadic Bedouin tribes, Wadi Rum is a quiet getaway of stars, sand and sun; a perfect complement from Amman's epicenter. Once inhabited by the Nabataeans of prehistoric times, Wadi Rum allows you to get lost in large landscapes and horizon lines. **Stay in the tent in Wadi Rum desert** and experience a magical, illuminated desert landscape in unique, moonlit scenery with optimal stargazing and view of the Milky Way in a soft, ethereal glow.

Wadi Rum is home of the Bedouins where the human race has inhabited this land for nearly 12,000 years. On arrival, check-in to the Bedouin camp placed in the vast desert. Enjoy the sunset in Wadi Rum along with a delicious dinner of different taste with an unbelievable experience to stay in a tent within the desert.


Day 5

By Road

DAY 05: 6TH MAR, WADI RUM – AMMAN
Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, enjoy **desert safari with 4x4 Wheel Drive** along with few stops at the dunes, canyons and spring with **Nabataeans** inside their tents. **Wadi Rum is said to be the rarest stone desert** among other deserts worldwide. It is a protected area covering 720 square kilometers of dramatic desert wilderness in the south of Jordan. Huge mountains of sandstone and granite emerge, sheer-sided, from wide sandy valleys to reach heights of 1700 meters and more. Narrow canyons and fissures cut deep into the mountains and many conceal ancient rock drawings etched by the peoples of the desert over millennia. You'll find an ancient silk route of camel station.

After the tour, have lunch in the tent at Wadi Rum and then proceed to Amman.

Amman - the capital of Jordan, is a modern city with numerous ancient ruins. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Have dinner and stay overnight in Amman.



DAY 06: 7TH MAR, AMMAN – JERASH – AMMAN

By Road

Day 6

Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, enjoy **Amman city tour** including Citadel – a historical site in the center of downtown Amman and Roman Theatre - a 6,000-seat, 2nd-century Roman theatre which dates back to the Roman period when the city was known as Philadelphia. Witness 64 columns of roman ruins in almost good shape and corridor of chariot. Then visit the old and new part of the city of Amman.



Next, drive to **Jerash**. It is considered as one of the largest and most well preserved sites of Roman architecture in the world outside of Italy and its history goes back to more than 6,500 years. Continue to visit **Ajloun Castle**. This 12th-century Muslim citadel crowns a hilltop of the Mount Ajloun district in north-western Jordan. The castle was built by the Ayyubids to guard the three valleys descending towards the Jordan Valley. In the 13th century, Ajloun Castle was expanded by the Mamluks, who built its gate and added a new tower. Return to the hotel in Amman. Have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.



Day 7

By Road

DAY 07: 8TH MAR, AMMAN – ALLENBY BRIDGE – JERICHO – NAZARETH – TIBERIUS
Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed from Jordan to Israel, by crossing the border and Allenby Bridge.

Welcome to Israel. Meet the local representative at Allenby Bridge, from the border and proceed to Jericho. Jericho is a Palestinian city in the West Bank and is known as the world's oldest city. It was the first city captured by the Israelites after their 40 years of wandering in the desert after the exodus from Egypt. Enjoy an **orientation tour of Jericho**. After the tour, have local lunch and drive to **Bethania**, then proceed to **Nazareth**.



Visit the **Site of Annunciation**. According to the Gospel of Luke, Nazareth was the home of Joseph and Mary. Some believe that it is the place where Angel Gabriel told Mary that she would have Jesus as her son

Later, proceed to **Tiberius**. Nazareth is the childhood home of Jesus, a major Christian pilgrimage site, while Tiberius is a city on the Sea of Galilee that became the final home of the Sanhedrin, the ancient Jewish legislative and judicial body, after the destruction of Jerusalem.



Have dinner, check-in to the hotel and stay overnight at Tiberius.

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DAY 08: 9TH MAR, TIBERIUS – SEA OF GALILEE – BETHLEHEM

Day 8

Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Tiberius and proceed to Jerusalem.

Enjoy the “**Jesus Boat**” ride at the **Sea of Galilee**, which is the lowest fresh water lake on earth about 212 meters or 700 feet below sea level. This lake supports Israel’s life and agriculture today, just as it did in the past.

Next, visit **Cafernaum**, Jewish fishing village from 2nd century B.C on the northern shores of the Sea of Galilee that is significant as the location of many events in the life of Jesus and is now an important archaeological site. It was a center for Jesus' ministry, where he taught in the local synagogue, performed miracles and stayed at the house of St. Peter. Then, visit **Tabgha**, the church of Loaves and Fishes, **Church of Beatitudes**, **St. Peter’s House** and **Cana Nazareth**, a picturesque city and one of the best places of North Israel and known as home town of Jesus.

Then proceed to Bethlehem in the south of Jerusalem. Check-in to the hotel and have dinner followed by an overnight stay.



Day 9

By Road

DAY 09: 10TH MAR, BETHLEHEM – TEL AVIV – JAFFA – JERUSALEM – BETHLEHEM
Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, drive for almost three hours’ and visit the vibrant city of **Tel Aviv**, a city on Israel’s **Mediterranean coast**. Tel Aviv is famous for its beautiful beaches, fantastic food, rich history, vibrant nightlife, dynamic culture, and modern architecture. It's often referred to as 'the city that never sleeps' due to its lively entertainment scene. Next, visit the city of **Jaffa** hailed as being one of the oldest operating ports in Israel and a center of connection between the Jewish and Arab Israeli communities. The entire area is packed with mosques, art, history, hummus, clothes and the most gorgeous stretches of beaches along the blue Mediterranean waters.

Have lunch and return to the old city of Jerusalem considered holy to the three major Abrahamic religions—Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. Visit **Golgotha**, the biblical name for the site immediately outside Jerusalem's walls where Jesus was said to have been crucified. Next, visit **Wailing Wall**, a remnant of the ancient wall surrounding the Jewish Temple’s country yard and most sacred sites of Judaism and **Ein Karem**, an ancient village and the birthplace of John the Baptist. According to Christian tradition, it was within the area now occupied by the Church of the **Holy Sepulchre** - The place where Jesus Christ rose from the dead. Then, return to the hotel in Bethlehem for an overnight stay.



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DAY 10: 11TH MAR, BETHLEHEM – MOUNT OLIVES – BETHLEHEM

Day 10

Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to **Mount Olives or Mount Olivet** in East Jerusalem from where you can have the best views of Jerusalem along with the **Jewish Cemetery** holding thousands of graves.

Then we will proceed to **Garden of Gethsemane** across the **Kidron Valley** at the foot of Mt. Olives where Jesus is said to have prayed with his disciples on the night before crucifixion. While the above title is a matter of opinion; there are a lot of reasons to validate the claim. For example, the location of the Mount of Olives is a perfect place to take in views of the Temple Mount and the rest of the Old City.

Next, visit the birthplace of Jesus - **The Church of Nativity**. The Church is a World Heritage site and was the first to be listed under Palestine by **UNESCO**. The site is also on **UNESCO's List of World Heritage in Danger**. Entering the church that marks the site of Christ's birthplace means having to stoop low. The only doorway in the fortress-like front wall is just 1.2 meters high. It is named for the grotto it was built around. This grotto is known by Christians as the birthplace of Jesus. Return to the hotel, have dinner & stay overnight in Bethlehem.



Day 11

By Road

DAY 11: 12TH MAR, BETHLEHEM – ALLENBY BRIDGE – DEAD SEA – AMMAN
Meals: Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Bethlehem and proceed to **Allenby Bridge** to cross the border of Israel on the way back to Amman in Jordan.

After finishing all formalities, journey towards the coast of the **Dead Sea in Jordan**, the lowest point on earth almost 400 meters below sea level and the world's saltiest water body - 9.6 times as salty as the ocean, where you will not sink due to the high salinity in the lake and large salt deposits on the sea floor. It's the world's deepest hypersaline lake with therapeutic waters. It's warm weather, filtered sun ray, oxygen-rich air, famous mineral-rich black mud and curative waters make it the largest natural spa in the world. Its water is known for being rich in healing properties, stress-combating Magnesium, body-energizing and moisture-balancing Potassium and water retention preventing Calcium. It also contains Bromide, which eases muscle stiffness and Sodium, which is essential for lymphatic fluid balance. Spend some time here at leisure. You can relax or swim and have a memorable experience at the Dead Sea.

After such an exciting experience, return to Amman.

Have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at Amman.
