### Day 01: 08<sup>th</sup> Mar, DEPART FROM KOLKATA

#### Meal on Board

Later, visit Mt. Gamaksan Suspension Bridge. In the evening, we visit **Myeongdong Market** – one of the most vibrant and diverse markets in Seoul. It has many local, international brands and department stores lined streets and alleys, selling everything from cosmetics, clothes, shoes to accessories.

In the evening, enjoy **Han River Cruise**. A Han River cruise is a boat tour in Seoul, South Korea, offering beautiful views of the city's skyline, stunning night views and sunset vistas and landmarks like Lotte Tower and the impressive Dragon Bridge.

Later, enjoy dinner in the restaurant and stay overnight at Seoul.

Next, visit **Seoul Tower** also known as Namsan Tower, by cable car to get an amazing view of Seoul city.

## Day 05: 12<sup>th</sup> Mar, SEOUL – BUSAN

### Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to Seoul railway station to board the high speed train to Busan.

On arrival at Busan, proceed to **Gamcheon Cultural Village**, a colourful mountain village in Busan, known for its beautiful landscape that portrays a unique blend of art, history and stunning scenery. It was formed by refugees of the Korean war who built their houses in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain. Known for its rows of colourful terraced houses standing along the steep, labyrinthine alleys and mountainside in Busan, it is nicknamed as 'Machu Picchu of Korea'. Vibrant murals and sculptures decorated Gamcheon Culture Village and the colourful, quirky community of Lego-shaped homes, cafes and galleries makes it ideal for an hour or two of strolling and selfies.

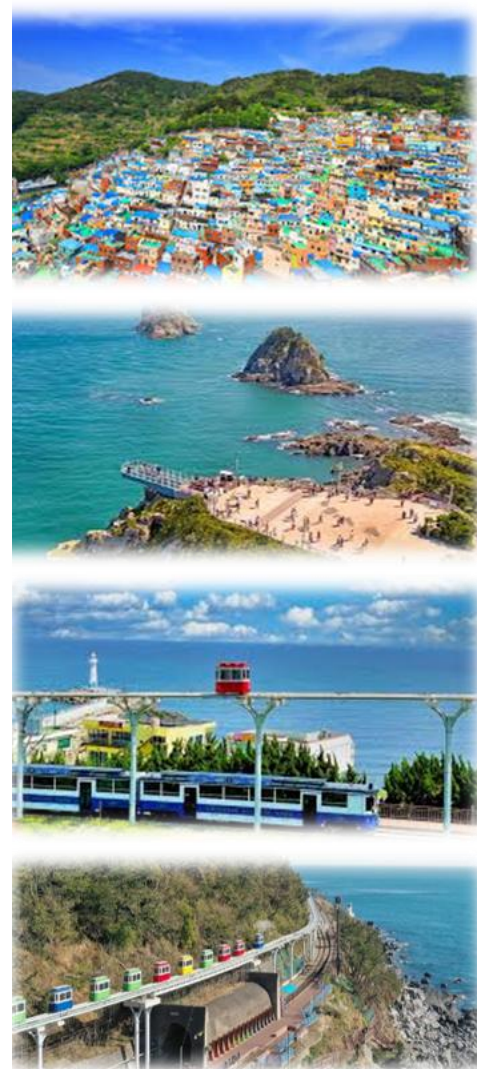
Next, visit **BIFF Square** which is the heart of the Busan International Film Festival, featuring a stage for diverse events and handprints of famous actors and actresses. It is also the main shopping district full of trendy boutiques and unpretentious eateries serving barbecue and fried seafood. Pass by the **Gujike traditional market**. Next, feel the adrenaline at the **Oryukdo Skywalk** standing on glass floor, watching waves crash beneath your feet. Perched over a 35-meter high coastal cliff, this horseshoe-shaped clear bulletproof glass walkway offers breathtaking views and a unique perspective of the coastal scenery. It's a glass skywalk overhanging Sea of Japan where the South Sea and East Sea meets.

Next, proceed to **Haeundae Blue Line Park** is a scenic coastal park in Busan. Board the **Haeundae Blue Line Park Sea Train**- a scenic coastal train in Busan, South Korea, that runs between Mipo and Songjeong, stopping at Cheongsapo and other locations. It offers a relaxing way to enjoy ocean views along the waterfront and provides stunning views of the coastline and the sea.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Busan.

**Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner**

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the airport to board the flight from Busan in South Korea to Taipei in Taiwan. Taiwan is known for its advanced technology industry, particularly in semiconductor manufacturing, and for its vibrant culture which includes bustling night markets, diverse cuisine, and stunning natural landscapes. The island is also recognized for its strong economy, democratic values, and unique blend of traditional and modern influences.

On arrival at Taipei, complete the immigration formalities and board the coach to drive to the vibrant capital city of Taipei, the capital and largest city of Taiwan, known for its blend of modern architecture and historic lanes, bustling night markets and vibrant street food scene. As a major global city, it serves as Taiwan's political, economic, and cultural center and is a hub for high-tech industry. It is an island country located 160 kilometers from the south-eastern coast of the People's Republic of China. Taipei City is located on the northern edge of Taiwan, and is the country's fourth largest city.

Visit **Chiang Kai Shek Memorial Hall** and see the changing of the guards. The Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall is one of Taipei's most recognizable landmarks: vast, symmetrical, and beautifully maintained. The marble steps, blue-tiled roof, and wide plaza create a sense of ceremony and the changing of the guard is executed with precision. Next, visit the **Longshan Temple**, one of the city's oldest and most famous temples. Built in 1738, it is dedicated to the Goddess of Mercy, Guanyin, and also honors several other deities. It was the center of religion, self-governance, and self-defense for Manka locals during the Qing Dynasty. Then, proceed towards **Taipei 101 Tower**, the world's tallest building in 2004. It is a significant architectural landmark known for its unique bamboo-like design, high-speed elevators, and a large tuned mass damper that helps stabilize the building during typhoons and earthquakes. The building also has an observation deck that offers panoramic views of the city. It stands 508 meters tall and has 101 floors, a design that is reflected in its name. Visitors can ride one of the world's fastest elevators to the top and enjoy both indoor and outdoor viewing platforms (Observatory Deck is included).

It stands 508 meters tall and has 101 floors, a design that is reflected in its name. It held the title of the world's tallest building from 2004 until 2010, when it was surpassed by the Burj Khalifa. End the tour with a visit to **Ximending Shopping District**, known as Shibuya of Taiwan and visit a wide range of shops and stores.

Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Taipei.



## Day 07: 14<sup>th</sup> Mar, TAIPEI – JIUFEN – SHIFEN – TAIPEI

**Meals: Breakfast, Light Local Lunch & Dinner**

Enjoy the breakfast in the hotel and set off to the scenic **Northern Coast tour**. Visit **Yehliu Geopark** where you can see the rocks in interesting formation and the ocean view. Known for its unique geological formations and stunning coastal views, Yehliu Geopark offers an unforgettable experience for nature enthusiasts and travellers alike. Visitors are captivated by the park's famous mushroom rocks, sea caves, tofu rocks, candle rocks, and giant's kettles.

Next, visit to **Jiufen Village**, a village which is also a nice place to shop the local souvenirs. Continue to **Shifen**, see the **Shifen Waterfall** and move to the rail area. Try to write your wishes on the sky lantern (4 pax sharing a huge lantern) and release it to the sky, and wish your dreams come true!

Return to Taipei. Have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel at Taipei.

## Day 08: 15<sup>th</sup> Mar, TAIPEI – YILAN – TAIPEI

**Meals: Breakfast, Light Local Lunch & Dinner**

After breakfast, proceed to visit Yilan, located on Taiwan's north-east coast, known for its natural beauty, diverse arboreal attractions, Qilan Sacred Trees, hot springs and rich culture. Yilan is famous for its delicious scallion pancakes made with fresh local green onions. In the Scallion Pancake DIY experience, visitors can learn how to make this beloved Taiwanese snack from scratch — from kneading the dough and adding fragrant scallions to pan-frying it to golden perfection.

Continue to visit **The National Center for Traditional Arts** in Yilan, a cultural park that showcases Taiwan's traditional crafts, architecture and performing arts. Continue to visit **Kavalan Whisky Distillery**, established in 2005 by the King Car Group, Kavalan that quickly gained international acclaim, earning titles such as Distillery of the Year and Best World Whisky at the 2025 International Whisky Competition.

Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and return to the hotel in Taipei for an overnight stay.

## Day 09: 16<sup>th</sup> Mar, TAIPEI – CEBU

**Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner**

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the airport to board the flight from Taipei in Taiwan to Cebu in Philippines.

Arrive at Cebu International Airport and complete all immigration formalities. Visit **Magellan's Cross**, symbol of Christianity in the Philippines. Located in the heart of Cebu City, Magellan's Cross is a significant historical landmark. Erected by Portuguese and Spanish explorers led by Ferdinand Magellan in 1521, this cross signifies the arrival of Christianity in the Philippines.

Next, proceed to see the **Basilica Minore del Santo Niño**, the country's oldest church and a historical and religious landmark in Cebu, Philippines. It is the oldest Roman Catholic church in the country, built on the spot where the image of the Santo Niño, an incarnation of Jesus as a child, was found by Spanish explorers in 1565.

Stop at **Fort San Pedro**, a 16th-century Spanish fortress. Fort San Pedro, located in Cebu City's Plaza Independencia. It is a historical monument dating back to 1565 under Miguel López de Legazpi. It has served various roles, from an army garrison to a zoo. It is the oldest and smallest fort in the nation and embodies Cebuano's heritage.

Next, drive through **Colon Street**, the oldest street in the Philippines and take panoramic photos at **Taoist Temple**, offering sweeping city views. Pass by **Fuente Osmeña Circle and Cebu Capitol Building**.

Later, have local dinner and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Cebu.



## Day 10: 17<sup>th</sup> Mar, CEBU – NALUSUAN ISLAND TOUR – CEBU

### Meals: Breakfast, Light Lunch & Dinner

Have breakfast in the hotel and depart for **Nalusuan Island Marine Sanctuary** which is approximately 45 min drive from Cebu. Then enjoy a boat ride for 20 minutes. Nalusuan Island is renowned for its marine sanctuary, featuring vibrant, shallow reefs teeming with diverse aquatic life. The crystal-clear waters make it an ideal spot for snorkeling, allowing close encounters with colorful fish. The island's restaurant offers a diverse menu of Filipino dishes, including barbecue pork, liempo, lemon chicken, crab sandwiches and shrimp sinigang. The ingredients are transported to the island by boat and frozen to maintain freshness. Enjoying these meals with the natural sea breeze and panoramic ocean views to make the dining experience truly special.

Enjoy the beautiful marine reserve. You can enjoy swimming, snorkelling and fish-feeding in crystal-clear waters. Relax on white-sand beaches or walk along the long wooden jetty. If you are interested in any water sports activities, you can opt for it at your own expense.

Later, return to Cebu, have dinner and stay overnight.

**Fort Santiago** is a historic citadel within Intramuros in Manila, built in 1571 by the Spanish to defend the city. It is a National Historical Landmark famous for being the prison of national hero José Rizal before his execution, and today serves as a popular tourist attraction with the Rizal Shrine Museum on its grounds. Visitors can explore its well-preserved walls, dungeons, and plazas. San Agustin Church & Museum, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Later, enjoy photo stops at **Rizal Park (Luneta)** and **Manila Cathedral**. Drive past **Cultural Center Complex, Roxas Boulevard and Mall of Asia**.

Later, enjoy dinner in the restaurant and transfer to Ninoy Aquino International Airport to board the late-night flight back to Kolkata.
